



Ocular Health Evaluation Method

To provide you with the best quality eye care, the doctors of Goldsmith Eye Care require an evaluation of the internal structures of your eyes.

You have two options: Optomap retinal photos OR dilation drops

Optomap Retinal Imaging: The optomap is a digital retinal screening that is non-invasive, **drop free** and has no side effects. Our California model is the latest in retinal imaging and takes the widest-angle photos available. These images take just seconds to capture and are immediately available to your doctor. They will then be compared to previous years to detect even the smallest of changes and stored for future comparison. Your doctor highly recommends this option.

Dilation Drops: This is the traditional view of the retina that has side effects. These side effects include blurred vision and light sensitivity lasting up to 24 hours. In some cases, the effects can also include headache, temporary eye irritation and redness. To complete this evaluation, a drop will be inserted into each eye, which takes about 30 minutes to expand the pupil. The doctor will then use a series of lights to assess the ocular health. Thorough documentation will be entered in your chart for reference in the upcoming years.

This evaluation is included in your exam.

Both options provide a thorough examination of your ocular health and fulfill requirements of post-LASIK and diabetic retinal examinations.
